CAP sUAS Mission Pilot Qualifications

- Annual CAPF-5u check ride required
- Bi-Annual CAPF-91u check ride for MP
- Capable of automated mission planning/mapping
- CAP MP are trained/qualified for night flight
- Safety equipment is as per client requirements

CAP sUAS Technician training

- Battery charging/management; scene security
- FAA Spotter qualified/ Most are F5u sUAS pilots
