

SURVEY CONTROL DATA IN QUADRANGLE 190

A 52 (USC&GS, 1934; Unicoi County, Tenn.)

Located about 4.3 miles west along the Erwin-White Rock Highway from Rocky Fork, along State Highway 36, about 5 feet north of the Tennessee-North Carolina State line fence, 18 feet west of the centerline of the highway, and 2 feet west of a fence. A standard disk, stamped "A 52 1934" and set in the top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 3106.851 feet or 946.970 meters (C-2)

A 59 (USC&GS, 1934; Madison County, N. C.)

Located about 8.3 miles northeast along State Highway 212 from White Rock, about 2.8 miles southwest of the North Carolina-Tennessee State line, 24 feet east of the centerline of a private road at the toe of a bluff, and 36 feet north of the centerline of the highway. A standard disk, stamped "A 59 1934", and set in the top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 2441.954 feet or 744.309 meters (C-2)

A 113 (USC&GS, 1935; Washington County, Tenn.)

Located 1.1 miles west of Telford by railroad, along the Southern Railroad, 155 yards southwest of milepost 39, 42 feet north of "Station 1 Mile" sign, 27.8 feet northeast of intersection of dirt road and north rail, 25.8 feet north of the north rail, level with top of rail. A standard disk, stamped "A 113 1935" and set on top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 1529.180 feet or 466.095 meters (C-2)

A 117 (USC&GS, 1935; Greene County, Tenn.)

Located 4.2 miles south of the post office by highway from Chuckey, along the Chuckey to Painter Road, 18 inches northwest of the northwest corner of the Cedar Grove Church, 51.5 feet south of the centerline of the roadway, 3 feet above the surface of the roadway. A standard disk, stamped "A 117 1935" and set on top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 1372.799 feet or 418.130 meters (C-2)

A 120 (USC&GS, 1935; Greene County, Tenn.)

Located 0.8 mile south of crossroads at Painter by highway, along Horse Creek Road, on property of John Bad, set in a pasture belonging to John Bad, 36 yards west of point where Horse Creek Road turns to the west, 13 feet north of centerline of roadway, 8.5 feet west of 18-inch apple tree, 6 inches above surface of highway. A standard disk, stamped "A 120 1935" and set on top of concrete post.

ELEVATION: 1598.701 feet or 487.285 meters (C-2)

1389 ASH (USGS, 1902; Washington County, Tenn.)

Located about 0.2 mile west along the Southern Railway from the station at Limestone, at mileage 43.5, at the bridge over Limestone Creek, in the top of the northeast corner of the east concrete retaining wall, and 10 feet north of the centerline of the main track. A USGS standard disk, stamped "1389 ASH".

ELEVATION: 1387.343 feet or 422.863 meters (C-2)

1470 ASH (USGS, 1902; Greene County, Tenn.)

Located about 6.1 miles east along the Southern Railway from Greenville, at Afton, in the brick foundation of the post office, 1 foot north of the southwest corner of the building, and 4 feet above the ground. A USGS standard disk, stamped "1470" and set vertically.

ELEVATION: 1468.813 feet or 447.695 meters (C-2)

1550 ASH (USGS, 1902; Washington County, Tenn.)

Located 150 feet northwest of the station at Telford, in the east wall at the southwest corner of brick store of E. W. King, occupied by J. L. Humphreys. An aluminum tablet, stamped "1550 ASH".

ELEVATION: 1548.39 feet (G-3)

B 52 (USC&GS, 1934; Unicoi County, Tenn.)

Located about 2.2 miles west along the Erwin-White Rock Highway, from Rocky Fork, about 2 miles east of the Tennessee-North Carolina State line, about 200 feet east of the east line of a 2-story frame house, about 110 feet west of a fence corner, 15 feet north of the centerline of the highway, 9 feet east of a gate post, and 1 foot north of a fence. A standard disk, stamped "B 52 1934" set in the top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 2681.766 feet or 817.401 meters (C-2)

B 59 (USC&GS, 1934; Madison County, Tenn.)

Located about 9.3 miles northeast along State Highway 212 from White Rock, about 1.9 miles southwest of the North Carolina-Tennessee State line, opposite the Worley Shelton house, and 21 feet east of the centerline of the highway. A standard disk, stamped "B 59 1934" and set in the top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 2711.366 feet or 826.426 meters (C-2)

B 113 (USC&GS, 1935; Washington County, Tenn.)

Located 1.1 miles southwest of the post office at Telford, by highway, 45 feet west of the west side of C. J. Greenway's residence, along U. S. Highway 11E, 25 feet east of the centerline of highway, 18 feet south of the centerline of T-road to east, 8.8 feet south of the northwest fence corner, level with surface of highway. A standard disk, stamped "B 113 1935" and set on top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 1599.147 feet or 487.421 meters (C-2)

B 117 (USC&GS, 1935; Greene County, Tenn.)

Located 5.1 miles south of the post office at Chuckey, by highway, along county road leading south from Chuckey, in the northeast corner of yard belonging to Glenn Jaynes, 45 yards east of house owned by Glenn Jaynes, 24 feet west of the centerline of roadway, 14 feet west of fence corner, beside hog lot, level with surface of roadway. A standard disk, stamped "B 117 1935" and set on top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 1477.300 feet or 450.282 meters (C-2)

B 120 (USC&GS, 1935; Greene County, Tenn.)

Located 1.8 miles southwest of crossroads at Painter, by highway, along the Horse Creek Road, 50 yards east of abandoned quarry, 100 feet east of the west vertex of triangular road intersection and within triangle, 26 feet south of the centerline of gravel road running east and west, at fence line, level with top of surface of the highway. A standard disk, stamped "B 120 1935" and set on top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 1646.634 feet or 501.895 meters (C-2)

BIG BUTT (USC&GS, 1893; Madison County, N. C., Unicoi County, Tenn.)

Located on the central one of three high peaks on top of Big Butt

Mountain (known locally as "Gravelly Knob"), about 20 miles southeast of Greenville, 15 miles south of Chuckey on Southern Railway, and on or near North Carolina-Tennessee State line. To reach from Erwin, go south 8.6 miles on U. S. Route 23 to gravel road on right which crosses concrete bridge at stone filling station and store, cross bridge, follow gravel road 4.7 miles to fork, keep straight ahead on right fork, continue 7.0 miles to Mill Creek, follow up creek 1.6 miles to farm of Millard Shelton and end of truck travel. Follow well-worn trail about 2-1/4 miles to top of mountain and about 1-1/4 miles along top to Gravelly Knob and station site. Original station mark was drill hole at intersection of north-and-south and east-and-west grooved lines on large rock flush with the ground. This rock was found dug up in 1930 and station was reestablished with standard disk station mark in drill hole in rock, about 2 feet below surface of ground and probably within several inches of original position. In 1933 large stone, probably original station mark, marked with drill hole and letters "USGS" was found about 4 feet west of present station.

Original reference marks were drill holes and arrows in rock outcrops. Two of these points were re-marked in 1930 with standard reference disks with the arrows pointing toward the station, each wedged in a drill hole in a boulder.

Reference Mark 1: 3.372 meters (11.06 feet) from station in geodetic azimuth 354°37'.

Reference Mark 2: 5.125 meters (16.81 feet) from station in geodetic azimuth 301°56'.

Remaining drill hole, 11.79 feet from station in geodetic azimuth 85°00' could not be found in 1930.

Reference Mark 3: a standard disk reference mark with the arrow pointing toward the station wedged in a drill hole in outcropping bedrock, established in 1933, is on northwest side of trail which leads to most northerly of peaks on top of mountain, and approximately 0.4 mile from station in geodetic azimuth 132°10'26".

BIG ROCK (USGS, 1934; Greene County, Tenn., Madison County, N. C.)

Located about 18.6 miles north and 2.7 miles east of Marshall on the Tennessee-North Carolina State line, being on the highest point of Big Butt Mountain. To reach the station from Marshall Post Office, drive west on U. S. 35 and 70, 11.6 miles, turn right on North Carolina No. 208, 3.55 miles, turn right on North Carolina No. 212, 16.25 miles, take second class road up Mill Creek 1.6 miles to home of Mildred Shelton. Leave car here and walk in northerly direction up old road, about 1/2 mile up said road take Forest Service trail to the right, keep this trail to top of mountain and thence with same trail out main level of mountain to station. Station is a Forest Service marker in top of large rock, stamped "BIG ROCK - 1934".

Reference Mark 1: Forest Service Class "A" brass marker in large rock with arrow pointed toward station, S 71° E, 23.78 feet.

Reference Mark 2: Forest Service Class "A" brass marker in large rock with arrow pointed toward station, S 38° E, 19.0 feet.

BM 51 (USC&GS, 1935; Washington County, Tenn.)

Located about 4.0 miles west of junction of Highways 81 and 107 at Embreeville, along State Highway 107, 39 feet southwest of junction of Highway 107 and Telford Road, 34 feet east of John Sevier Memorial marker, 0.1 mile west of concrete bridge, 19 feet south of the centerline of highway. A spike driven in a 2-foot apple tree, 1 foot below level of highway.

ELEVATION: 1474.748 feet or 449.504 meters (C-2)

C 52 (USC&GS, 1934; Unicoi County, Tenn.)

Located at Rocky Fork, on the Erwin-White Rock Highway, 21 feet south of the northwest corner of a school yard, 14 feet east of the centerline of the highway, and 1 foot east of a fence. A standard disk, stamped "C 52 1934" and set in the top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 2155.242 feet or 656.919 meters (C-2)

C 59 (USC&GS, 1934; Madison County, N. C.)

Located about 10.4 miles northeast along State Highway 212 from White Rock, about 0.8 mile southwest of the North Carolina-Tennessee State line, about 6 feet west of the west line of the Corbett Shelton log cabin, and about 30 feet north of the centerline of the highway. A standard disk, stamped "C 59 1934" and set in the top of a concrete post.

ELEVATION: 2975.463 feet or 906.923 meters (C-2)

C 113 (USC&GS, 1935; Washington County, Tenn.)

Located 2.1 miles southwest of the post office by highway, from Telford, on U. S. Highway 11 E, set in east end of southwest retaining wall of concrete bridge over a small creek, 35 yards south of the entrance of J. F. Copp's home, 25 feet north of power pole No. 145, 10 feet west of centerline of the highway, level with surface of highway. A standard disk, stamped "C 113 1935".

C 117 (USC&GS, 1935; Greene County, Tenn.)

Located 2.6 miles north of crossroads at Painter, by highway, and 24

with No. 208, turn on No. 208, and go 3.6 miles, turn right on No. 212, go 6-1/2 miles to Rock Branch, turn left go 0.9 mile, leave car and follow government trail northerly about 1 mile to gap, thence westerly along ridge to the top of mountain and station. Station is a drill hole in rock set in place directly under signal in 22-inch hickory.

To reach from Erwin, drive south on Highway 19 W, 9.1 miles, turn right at Gulf Milling Station, crossing creek on concrete bridge, follow gravel road along left bank of creek 2.2 miles, turn right at gravel road near large boulder, follow gravel road up very steep grade, 0.5 mile to farm house where road turns sharp to right, leave car, follow trail to saddle, turn left going up drain, approximately 700 feet to extreme top of ridge at northeast corner of cornfield, go southwest 222 feet, 20 feet southwest of field, on comb of ridge, 100 feet south from south corner of woods, 30 feet north of clump of bushes. Station is a 1- by 1-inch angle iron, stamped "TVA LR 207 1938".

Station is a 1- by 1-inch angle iron, stamped "TVA LR 227 1938".

To reach from the Post Office at Erwin, Tennessee, drive north on Highway 19 W and 23, 0.1 mile, turn left on Highway 81, go 5.2 miles to intersection of gravel road, turn left on gravel road through Embreeville, go 3.8 miles to Y in roads at creek, take right hand fork, go 0.4 mile to newlybuilt bin for ore at mouth of small ore mine tunnel. Leave car, go N 20° W to extreme top of ridge, about 2000 feet. Station is on highest point of small knoll, 20 feet east of twin 10-inch oak, directly up hill from ore mine, at intersection of ridge and spur ridge to mines. Top of ridge is almost clear except for three pines and two oaks. Station is 1- by 1-inch angle iron, stamped "TVA LR 242 1938".

From the centerline intersection of roads, point is S 45° W 28 feet, and 1 foot west of wire fence line in field. Station is a 1- by 1-inch angle iron, stamped "TVA LR 243 1938".

To reach from Erwin, Tennessee, Post Office, go 0.1 mile north on Highway 19 W and 23, turn left on Highway 81, go 12.3 miles, turn left on gravel road, go 0.1 mile, turn left go 0.9 mile, turn right go 0.3 mile, turn left go 0.5 mile to farm house in Y in roads, 35 feet southwest of the centerline intersection of roads and 1 foot east of base of pear tree in yard, driven flush with the ground, 10 feet west of two mail boxes along the side of road 10 feet northeast from the northeast corner of house. Station is a 1- by 1-inch angle iron, stamped "TVA LR 244 1938".

To reach from Erwin, Tennessee, drive north on Highway 23 and 19 W, go 0.1 mile, turn left on Highway 81, go 7.2 miles, turn left on Highway 107 go 17.6 miles, turn left go 4.0 miles to gravel road, turn right, go 1.5 miles to small village of Greystone, go about 100 feet beyond log church, leave car, walk northwest to right, about 300 feet to 18-inch dead chestnut tree, about 50 feet high, at the base of tree on top of small rise, 200 feet northwest from northwest corner of log church. Station is a 1- by 1-inch angle iron, stamped "TVA LR 310 1938".

Proceed some 150 yards to field road to north, drive along same through south edge of field to end of road at the northwest corner of woods and fence line west, leave car and climb to high point on ridge clearly visible to northeast, on high point of ridge driven 6 inches above ground in fence corner. Station is a 1- by 1-inch angle iron stamped "LR 311".

Leave car at old farm house, go south up hollow to top of ridge about 1200 feet, turn left when on ridge going about 200 feet to large rock outcrop at top of steep slope and 75 feet southeast of angle in ridge line, 40 feet southeast of tall evergreen tree on lone bald spot on ridge. Station is a 1- by 1-inch angle iron, stamped "TVA LR 316 1938".

A standard disk, stamped "M 59 1934" and set in the top of a concrete post.

A standard disk, stamped "Z 116 1935" and set on top of a concrete post.
